OTHER PUBLIC BUSINESS:-

1107. Councillor Rampersad Hardial made the under mentioned comments/requests:-

- (i) Complained about the lack of pipe borne water supply for over two (2) weeks in Clarke Road and Old Clarke Road areas. Calls to WASA only resulting in promises but no water and gave notice that, if the situation continues, the residents would be demonstrating.
- (ii) Commended the Road Officer II and his staff and the Contractor(s) responsible for the work done at the Barrackpore Recreation Ground pavilion, and a box drain in Ramkaliah Trace.

1108. Councillor Willvan Ramlakhan made the under mentioned comments/requests:-

- (i) He was happy that an estimate was presented for the repairs to wooden bridges because some were in urgent need of repairs with the spike nail protruding. The Katwaroo Trace wooden bridge especially, cannot take the load offered by the contractors in the area. He request an estimate be done to convert that bridge into concrete.
- (ii) People were complaining about the irregularity of the scavenging, with no service for up to two (2) weeks in some areas. However, the Supervisors always say the job was done 100 percent. The Principal of Picton Presbyterian School reported to him that the truck picked up their garbage once per week.
- (iii) He attended the function held by the Scouts of Penal and was surprised at the number of youths who were involved. All the preparatory work was done by the Scouts themselves and he felt the Corporation should render some assistance to them. He would take up the challenge and try to provide assistance in obtaining an electricity supply to their camp.
- (iv) The estimate for earthfill for completion of box drains was very timely since it would enhance the 'finishing up' of the box drains. In Digits Trace alone a job had to be repaired three (3) times which shows the lack of commitment to jobs.
- (v) Food prices were increasing every day and nothing was being done by this government and soon there would be a time when people will starve because they would not be able to afford the necessities.
- (vi) The crime situation was worsening to the extent that a judge had to make remarks about this. People fear for their lives therefore they are not giving evidence and the criminals are released to roam free.
- (vii) There is a development taking place in Lachos Road, Penal where thousands of loads of earthfill were transported. The person indicated that he was willing to supply the Corporation and the Corporation should pursue. He also requested that a letter is sent to the person (Billy Ramdeen) for the restoration of the roadway and clearing of the clogged drains before the onset of the rainy season.
- (viii) Requested two (2) loads of gravel and oil-sand for the Penal Presbyterian Church yard.

1109. **Councillor Sonnylal B. Manwah made the under mentioned comment/requests:-**

- (i) After years of begging the Corporation to construct the road leading to the Friendship Recreation Ground and Jordon Hill Recreation Ground, he thanked the Roads Section and Transport Section for moving feverishly to have the road started in order for the clubs to get sand to fix the cricket pitches. Matches had to be cancelled because of this and again thanked Mr. Bassarath and Mr. Alexander for their assistance.
- (ii) An evening football competition was held at the Golconda recreation ground, but because of the poor lighting system the matches had to be played during the day time. He pleaded many times to replace the blown bulbs and the flood lights which have not been done to date.
- (iii) Requested the roller to roll Friendship Recreation Ground so cricket could start.
- (iv) Requested the Health Section to clean the road verges at Golconda but they didn't.

1110. **Councillor Roy Kissoon made the under mentioned comments/requests:-**

- (i) Request two (2) signs be erected indicating the maximum weight of vehicles to pass along Jacksingh Street.
- (ii) The garbage truck was not servicing Hermitage Village and the residents were putting their garbage to the top of the street and placing it on a concrete foundation. He requested the relevant Section remove the foundation.
- (iii) Thanked Mr. Zaffar for introducing spot patching in his area.
- (iv) Thanked Roads Section for paving the street and establishing a turning point in 'New Village Extension' roadway.
- (v) Requested the truck, backhoe and backfill for the continuation of a water project in Hermitage.
- (vi) Requested the grader to do some work at La Fortune Recreation Ground.

1111. **Councillor Roland A. Hall made the under mentioned comments/requests:-**

- (i) Observed that the standards of the meetings, and the meeting place, have deteriorated. The protocol with regards to the Chairman's chain was not observed, also the Council Hall should not be used as a store room for chairs.
- (ii) Extended greetings and congratulations to Mr. Bassarath, the first Vice President of the T&T Cricket Board on the success of the T&T cricket squad in the Stanford 20/20 tournament. He indicated that some of the players live in this region and the Corporation should seriously pursue the naming of the Darren Ganga Recreation Ground.

1112. **Councillor Carl Dibideen made the under mentioned comments/ request:-**

- (i) Issues such as health crisis, the scourge of crime, traffic congestion, and traffic problems are discussed and analysed at every Statutory meeting, but we have no control over these situations. Members have to recognize and understand their roles and responsibilities and be focused on this. He added that month after month Members talk at statutory meetings but were not following up at the Committee stage.

1113. **CHAIRMAN'S CLOSING REMARKS:-**

- (i) Administration to put all things in place to start truck borne water by Monday 3rd March, 2008. Also Members of Council to recommend Checkers.

- (ii) Complemented the Road Officer and his gang for an excellent job done with the road leading up to the water hydrant.
- (iii) Reminded all of the meeting to discuss the traffic plan for Penal central to be held at 1:00pm later that day.
